LESSON 5

Where do you live?

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- **Attendance**
- Have each student spell his/her first and last name.

Introduction

- Cities and Towns: Where do you live?
- Write the names of cities and towns in your area. Introduce the **name**
- **sign** for these cities. Review name signs and point to the city's real

world orientation. For example:

Oshawa Ajax

Scarborough Toronto Pickering Bowmanville

Port Perry

Whitby



Then sign:

T: ME LIVE IX-loc "city on board", IX-loc "direction of city".

If students don't understand LIVE, sign:

T: ME HOUSE SLEEP EAT IX-LOC "city on board".

- Sign the phrase "NEAR (city with name sign)" for cities that don't have name signs.
- For example: for Pontypool: **ME LIVE NEAR fs-PP** (Port Perry)
- Ask students to point toward **actual location** of various cities, towns.

whq (Use real-world orientation.) T: (city) WHERE.

Next, ask each student where he/she lives.

* NOTE: "IX-loc" means "over there" and is used to show locations.
