

Leaf Blower Operator's Manual

Eye Protection –

Always wear eye protection when operating the blower.



Hand Protection –

Wear no-slip, heavy duty work gloves to improve your grip on the blower handle. Gloves also reduce the amount of vibration transmitted to your hands.



Breathing Protection –

Wear a face mask to protect against dust.



Hearing Protection –

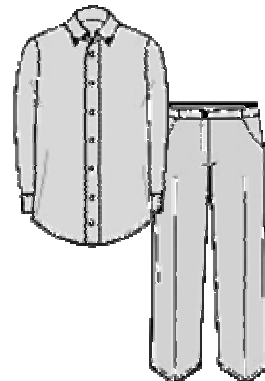
The manufacturer recommends wearing hearing protection whenever unit is being used.



Proper Clothing –

Wear snug fitting, durable clothing;

- ♦ Pants - long legs, shirt - long sleeves.
- ♦ DO NOT WEAR SHORTS,
- ♦ DO NOT WEAR TIES, SCARVES, JEWELRY.



Wear sturdy work shoes with non-skid soles;

- ♦ DO NOT WEAR OPEN TOED SHOES,
- ♦ DO NOT OPERATE UNIT BAREFOOTED.

Keep long hair away from engine and blower intake. Retain hair with cap or net.

Hot Humid Weather –

Heavy protective clothing can increase operator fatigue which may lead to heat stroke. Schedule heavy work for early morning or late afternoon when temperatures are cooler.
