Safe Handling of Soiled Laundry

Nursing Home Laundry and Linen Service

- Wash hands before and after contact with each patient.
- Eating and drinking in the lunch area only.
- Staff must wear gowns, masks and gloves when sorting soiled linen.
- All cuts and scrapes must be covered with a waterproof bandage.
- Rubber gloves must be used when handling laundry with blood and body fluids.
- A clean uniform must be worn daily.
- Soiled linen must be bagged to contain any and all body fluids.
- Soiled linen must be removed from patient care areas at least once daily. (more often as required)
- All clean linen must be put in carts which have been decontaminated.
- The soiled linen carts must be cleaned at least daily, and the clean linen carts, cleaned weekly.
